

BEHAVIOR POLICY

Little Scholars and University of Richmond expect students enrolled in our camps to observe school rules and to respect their fellow campers, teachers, and UR faculty and staff. If the actions of one camper compromises their own safety, or the safety of other students, our teachers, or our On-Site Coordinator in any way, the following action steps will be taken:

First offense- Little Scholars' On-Site Coordinator will work with the child and teachers to address the behavior. This might include steps such as diverting the child's attention to other activities or accompanying the child on a walk to take a break. The On-Site Coordinator will notify Little Scholars' Program Coordinator.

Second offense- Little Scholars' On-Site Coordinator will contact the guardian of the child to address the issue. This contact will occur at pick up or via phone call to the guardian during the camp day. The On-Site Coordinator will notify Little Scholars' Program Coordinator.

Third offense- Little Scholars' On-Site Coordinator will call the guardian, who will be required to immediately report to the camp in person to speak to the child directly. If the guardian does not arrive to correct the behavior within 30 minutes, or if the guardian is unable to calm the child, they will be required to remove the child from the camp for the remainder of that camp day.

Fourth offense- Little Scholars' On-Site Coordinator will contact the guardian, who will be required to immediately pick their child up from the camp. The child will be removed from camp for the rest of the summer program. The UR guardian will be responsible for paying the \$50 cancellation fee (payroll deduction) for any future camp weeks for which the child was registered.
