

# Does W&L manage registration for summer camps?

No. W&L does not manage registration information. Little Scholars handles all registration and camp administration. If you have a question about a specific registration, withdrawal, or camp session, please contact Little Scholars directly (nbrown@littlescholarsllc.com or 804-447-4095).

## When does registration for camp open and close?

Camp registration will open on Tuesday March 18<sup>th</sup> at 8:00 am for W&L Faculty and Staff, Registration will open to the public on Monday March 24<sup>th</sup> at 8:00 am.

\$260 per student per week

## What if I need to cancel my registration?

Please communicate any cancellations directly with Little Scholars as soon as possible. Some cancellation fees may apply. Please see below for information about fees.

## What are the cancellation fees?

Full refunds (minus \$3.99 Sawyer fee) will be granted up to 7 days prior to the start of the camp. Within 7 days of the camp start date, only a 50% refund will be granted. No refunds will be granted on or after the program start date.

## What does my child need to bring to camp?

Each child should bring two snacks, a labeled water bottle, and lunch. Packed lunches must be non-perishable, as there is no access to a refrigerator.

# Can I bring my campers to camp late or leave early, or take them to lunch as my schedule dictates?

Yes, please notify Little Scholars directly and in advance to ensure a smooth check-in/out process daily in consideration of staff and other campers. You will need to sign your child out with a valid ID.

# What days will camp NOT be held?

There will be no camps on June 19th, or the week of July 4th.

## Where should my children be dropped off in the mornings?

Children will be dropped off in their classrooms in the morning.

# I'm unable to attend one of the parent information sessions. Will this information be posted online?

Yes, the information sessions will be recorded so that you can get more answers to any questions you may have.

### What age does my child need to be to attend?

Camps are designed for children who will be eligible for kindergarten in the fall of 2025 through rising sixth grade in the fall of 2025.

### How are the children split into camps?

Camps will be split by grades, depending on enrollment.

What will be required at pick up? ID (W&L ID or drivers lis.) will be required to pick up your child. If someone other than the parent or guardians listed on the permissions during registration will be picking up your child, we must have this in writing, and they will be required to show an ID at pick up.

#### Can my child bring electronic devices to camp?

We discourage students from bringing electronics to camp. If they do bring a device to camp, the teacher or OSC will hold onto the device during camp. LS is not responsible for any lost or damaged devices that are brought to camp.
